ORIGINAL PETITION FOR DIVORCE

1. Discovery Level

Discovery in this case, if needed, is intended to be conducted under level 1 of rule 190 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.

2. Parties

This suit is brought by John Doe, Petitioner. Petitioner’s driver’s license number is xxxxx333; Petitioner’s Social Security Number is xxx-xx-4444. Jane Doe is my spouse and the Respondent.

3. Domicile

Petitioner has been a domiciliary of Texas for the six-month period preceding the filing of this petition and a resident of this county for the ninety days preceding the filing of this Petition.

4. Service

If Petitioner is unable to obtain a Waiver of Citation, process should be served on Respondent at 555 Main Street, Dallas, Texas 75202, or such other place as Respondent may be found. If Respondent cannot be personally served then Respondent should be served by substitute service as authorized by the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure or the applicable statutes.

5. Protective Order Statement

No protective order under title 4 of the Texas Family Code is in effect, and no application is pending with regard to the parties to this suit.

6. Dates of Marriage and Separation

The parties were married on or about January 1, 2000 and ceased to live together as husband and wife on or about June 25, 2020.

7. Grounds for Divorce

The marriage has become insupportable because of discord or conflict of personalities between Petitioner and Respondent that destroys the legitimate ends of the marriage relationship and prevents any reasonable expectation of reconciliation.

8. Children of the Marriage

My spouse and I do not have any biological or adopted children together who are under the age of 18; my spouse and I do not have any biological or adopted children together who are 18 years old or older and are still in high school; my spouse and I do not have any disabled children of any age; the wife has not had a child by another man since the date of marriage; and the wife is not pregnant.

9. Division of Community Property and Confirmation of Separate Property

Petitioner requests the Court to approve the agreement of the parties, if any, and if such an agreement is not made, Petitioner requests the Court to divide their estate in a manner that the Court deems just and right, as provided by law and to confirm to the respective parties their separate property.

10. Standing Order

If applicable, Petitioner attaches hereto the Dallas County Standing Order Regarding Children, Property and Conduct of the Parties.

11. Change of Name

The wife requests a change of name to Jane Smith which was a previously used name.

12. Prayer

Petitioner prays that citation and notice issue as required by law and that the Court grant a divorce and all other relief requested in this petition. Petitioner prays for general relief.
